Qualifications for submissions

We are looking for artwork that embodies mental health
illness, recovery and/or wellness. It must fit the following
criteria and not infringe upon copyrighted material:

You must be 18 years or older AND

- ◆ You have a mental illness or condition, short or long
term and create art. For example: you were grieving
and created this artwork to help you heal, **OR**
- ◆ You created this piece of artwork on the topic of
mental illness/wellness, **OR**
- ◆ You have loved ones that have a mental illness or
concern and you created this piece to help bring
awareness to the topic.

Artwork must be professionally finished.

Submitted Artwork must be framed, hangable,
contained, dry, durable enough for handling and must
be able to be put on an easel or tabletop.

**You may submit up to 3 pieces in person. \$10
each.* (Using online portal is \$15 ea.*/3 max)**

Min. size 8 x 8 inches/ Max. size 48 x 48 inches ea.

Each must have their own unique completed and
signed submission form.

*Fees are non-refundable and help underwrite the event.

**Drop off is May 31st, 2019 from 6-9 p.m.,
June 1st, 2019, from 10 a.m.-4 p.m.**

Items will be juried June 1st.
